SAM-GAM SA-RA-NAM GA-RA CHA - MI
I GO TO THE SANGHA FOR REFUGE

For Verse 2 ... insert  at the beginning of each line
DU-TI OM PEI *

** Dutiyaampi Buddham saranam gacchami
For a second time, I go to the Buddha for refuge.
Dutiyaampi Dhammam saranam gacchami
For a second time, I go to the Dhamma for refuge.
Dutiyaampi Sangham saranam gacchami
For a second time, I go to the Sangha for refuge.

For Verse 3 ... insert  at the beginning of each line
TRI-TI OM PEI

Tatiyaampi Buddham saranam gacchami
For a third time, I go to the Buddha for refuge.
Tatiyaampi Dhammam saranam gacchami
For a third time, I go to the Dhamma for refuge.
Tatiyaampi Sangham saranam gacchami
For a third time, I go to the Sangha for refuge.
